


STUDENT EMERGENCY COMFORT KITS

(To be brought by each student to school on the first day)

Bethany Lutheran Church, School & Early Learning Center is committed to providing a safe procedure in the event of an emergency. Should an emergency (earthquake, severe storm, police action etc.) occur, it may be necessary for your children to stay at Bethany for an extended period of time.

To make this stay as comfortable as possible, we request that you assemble an **Emergency Comfort Kit** for each of your children, and send with them on the first day of school. Please use the list below to assemble each kit. It is our prayer that we never have to use these kits, but the wisest course is to be prepared. We appreciate your cooperation!



<u>Each student</u> needs a **Gallon Ziploc bag**, marked with their name, containing the following:

REQUIRED:

*Food and Drinks:

- 1 disposable bottle of water
- 1 small can/carton juice
- 1 SNACK SIZE box dry cereal
- 1 small cup ready-to-eat pudding (non-refrigerated type) with plastic spoon
- 1 protein snack (energy bar, cheese/crackers, tuna/crackers, beef stick, or similar)
- 1 small package of dried fruit (raisins, etc.)
- *one large plastic trash bag (used for raingear, etc.)
- *one index card with at least one out-of-state family name & area code/phone number

RECOMMENDED:

- *3-day supply of any VITAL daily medications: (inhaler, EpiPen, insulin, etc.) (*if these are items we <u>already keep on hand</u> for your children in our medicine safe, there is no need to include them).
- *Special note from parents: Especially important for younger children, this is a comforting note to say you love them, that someone will come for them soon, to share a happy memory for them to think about, etc.
- *Family photo of happy times (optional, but it can be a real comfort as well).
